Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB 3073 strikes Section 1 in its entirety which removes all definitions of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act and removes a statutory reference to *palliative care*.

SAHB 3073 adds an exception that specifies that this act will not apply to a prescription for a patient who has sickle cell disease. The measure declares an emergency.

Fiscal Analysis

The Senate amendments to the measure remove new language defining palliative care and the new reference to such definition found in statute describing the prescription of opioids.

Upon review, the Senate amendments to the measure do not alter the fiscal impact of the measure as passed by the House. No direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure.
