Research Analysis

The CCS for HB 3083 adjusts apportionments for the 7 percent sales tax on medical marijuana. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and each fiscal year thereafter, apportionments will be as follows:

- 77.97 percent to the State Public Common School Building Equalization Fund to fund redbud school grants, not to exceed the amount of grant funds awarded;
- 13.56 percent to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for drug and alcohol rehabilitation and prevention, not to exceed \$8 million in any fiscal year; and
- 8.47 percent to the County Sheriff Public Safety Grant Revolving Fund created in the measure until June 30, 2025, and to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority Revolving Fund beginning July 1, 2025, not to exceed \$5 million in any fiscal year.

Any surplus collections will be apportioned to the General Revenue Fund.

The CCS also directs OMMA to establish programs and provide funding from the above apportionment to support county sheriffs to enforce medical marijuana laws and repeals [Enrolled HB 3530](#), which duplicates the County Sheriff Public Safety Grant Revolving Fund created in the CCS.
