HB 3501 requires the Department of Public Safety to recognize and act upon a report of conviction in a court of any federally recognized Indian tribe within Oklahoma or a court of the United States in the same manner it acts upon any report of conviction from an Oklahoma state or municipal court.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, as introduced, clarifies the process whereby the Department of Public Safety receives conviction notices from courts for the suspension and revocation of commercial driver licenses.
