## **Fiscal Analysis**

The fiscal impact of this measure is twenty-five million, five hundred fifty-seven thousand, eight hundred seventy-five dollars (25,557,875.00). The breakdown is as follows:

- \$4,000,000.00 for the Oklahoma State University College of Veterinary Medicine;
- \$1,500,000.00 for the Oklahoma State University College of Veterinary Medicine Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory;
- \$1,000,000.00 for the Oklahoma State University Agriculture Experiment Stations;
- \$2,000,000.00 for the Oklahoma State University Agricultural Extension Service;
- \$8,414,550.00 for rural fire operational grants;
- \$2,000,000.00 for Rural Fire 80/20 Match Program;
- \$800,000.00 for rural fire coordinators;
- \$330,000.00 for additional meat inspectors;
- \$513,325.00 for the Made in Oklahoma program; and
- \$5,000,000.00 for incorporated municipalities affected by extreme weather as described in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1091.
