**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB 1061 directs that appropriations to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services be expended in the following manner:

- \$1,920,000 for the Pay for Success program (the measure requires OMES to expend this amount according to certain population criteria);
- \$15,847,666 for the device as a service augmentation;
- \$150,000 for the study of human trafficking performed by the Oklahoma Commission on the Status of Women;
- \$35,737,000 for the implementation of Service Oklahoma;
- An amount unknown at this time shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to conduct Phase II of the Arbuckle-Simpson Hydrology Study.
