Research Analysis

SB 131 authorizes facilities without a pharmacy license to distribute or dispense dialysate or peritoneal dialysis devices necessary to perform home peritoneal dialysis to patients with end-stage renal disease (ESRD) provided certain conditions are met. Those conditions include:

- The dialysate must be comprised of dextrose or icodextrin
- Approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration
- Dialysate or dialysis devices are lawfully held by a manufacturer or agent properly licensed by the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy
- Dialysate or dialysis devices are delivered and sealed in original packaging
- Dialysate or dialysis devices are delivered only upon receipt of a physician's prescription by a licensed pharmacy
- The manufacturer delivers the dialysate or dialysis devices directly to the patient with ESRD or patient's health care provider

Dialysate and peritoneal dialysis devices supplied are not required to be certified by a pharmacist prior to being supplied by a manufacturer, wholesaler or distributor.
