Fiscal Analysis

SB 66 exempts school districts from the surplus lines premium tax. According to officials at the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this would create a loss in revenue to both OID and the State. OID would lose about \$129,377 in FY22 and the State's General Revenue Fund would lose about \$421,164. Therefore, there would be a negative revenue impact to the State.
