## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 751 in its current form repeals and eliminates the State Governmental Technology Applications Review Board (SGTARB). Officials for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) anticipate no negative fiscal impact as a result of the provisions of SB 751. Under existing statutory language members of SGTARB receive reimbursement for travel expenses from each member's respective agency or appointing authority. The elimination of SGTARB should result in travel reimbursement savings for such agencies and appointing authorities, though such savings are expected to be minimal.
