Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for SB774 authorizes the Wildlife Commission to prescribe the rules and regulations related to hunting and fishing licenses in the state.

The measure prohibits the Wildlife Commission from increasing the cost of a license or permit by an amount greater than the most recent annual percentage change in the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for the South Region statistical area.

The Commission may propose fee increases in excess of the annual percentage change only with approval by a majority vote of both House and Senate Wildlife Committees.

The Commission must notify the Pro Tem of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Chair of the Senate Agriculture and Wildlife committee, and Chair of the House Wildlife Committee of any fee changes that do not exceed the annual percentage change.
