SB 92 specifies the act of failing to include any amount paid by an enrollee or on behalf of an enrollee by another person when calculating the total contribution to an out-of-pocket maximum of the enrollee, deductible, copayment, coinsurance or other cost-sharing requirement as an unfair claims settlement practice.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 92 adds a violation to the Unfair Claims Settlement Practices Act for health insurers or pharmacy benefits managers. According to officials at the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this does not create a fiscal impact for OID. As OID is a nonappropriated agency, there is no fiscal impact to the State.
