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**Bill Analysis**

HB 1103 requires schools beginning in the 2022-23 school year to administer biennially the Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment Survey, a mental health prevention survey, for 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students, or an alternative survey. It directs the Department of Mental Health to maintain the survey and provide technical assistance. If a school chooses to administer an alternative survey, it must apply for a waiver from the Department of Mental Health. The bill states that the requirement for the survey is subject to availability of federal funding, and if funding is insufficient, administration of the survey is not required.
