**Bill Analysis**

HB 1149 requires persons engaged in the activities of a used motor vehicle sales to obtain a certificate of registration from the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission. The measure provides that the cost of any administrative fine is to be borne by the employing entity. A salesperson is deemed to be temporarily approved and allowed to sell vehicles when applications and fees are on file with the Commission. The measure authorizes a person to sell used motor vehicles without obtaining a separate used motor vehicle salesperson's certificate of registration if the person has a certificate of registration from the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission to sell new or unused motor vehicles at a new motor vehicle dealer's licensed franchise location which also sells used vehicles. The cost of the registration for each sales person is \$50.00 to be renewed biennially and may be transferred for a fee of \$25.00.
