**Bill Analysis**

HB 1631 requires nutrient management plans for new or expanding poultry feeding operations to be prepared by the operator or designee of the operator. The plan must be submitted to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry for review and approval. Every nutrient plan must be updated and submitted to the Department every 6 years. The measure also allows a current operator to submit a 1-page amendment to the most recently submitted plan in lieu of a renewal plan.
