**Bill Analysis**

HB 1709 changes a qualification for continuation of successful adulthood services. The services may continue until 21 years of age provided the individual is in the custody of the Department of Human Services or a federally recognized Indian tribe and in an out-of-home placement at the time of their sixteenth birthday. Current law stipulates that this must occur at the time of their eighteenth birthday.
