**Bill Analysis**

HB 1892 creates the Advisory Task Force on Prevention of Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation. The Task Force shall be comprised of 13 members and is directed to study human trafficking, prostitution, and child exploitation in the state. The Task Force is directed to create and provide a report of such studies to the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, the Speaker of the House, and the Governor by February 1, 2022. A Senate member of the Task Force is required to call the first meeting to order by September 1, 2021. Staff of the Oklahoma State Senate and Oklahoma House of Representatives shall jointly assist in staffing the Advisory Task Force.
