Bill Analysis

HB 2010 requires mobile food vendors seeking to operate in a county with a population of 400,000 or more that is governed by a city-county health department to obtain a food establishment license from the local authority. The license shall be recognized by the state Commissioner of Health and all local authorities as a state food establishment license. Vendors shall provide to the local authority their state license for recognition by the local authority before operating in the local authority's jurisdiction. The local authority must recognize lawful and valid state licenses and authorize mobile food vendors providing such licenses to operate within its jurisdiction. The measure outlines areas mobile food vendors may operate in after receiving such recognition. Mobile food vendors must obtain a contract or lease agreement from the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission prior to operating in state parks. The measure also authorizes local authorities to regulate the operation of mobile food vendors in a manner outlined in the measure. The measure also requires the Department of Public Safety to approve the mobile food establishment.
