Bill Analysis

HB 2396 directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to allow a series of in-depth prevention and education programs regarding sex trafficking and exploitation to all freshman students enrolled in institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. It directs institutions to provide all freshmen the opportunity to attend one of three on-campus, voluntary sex trafficking and exploitation prevention and education programs. It directs program materials relating to the programs to be provided at no cost, with the program provider being solely responsible for incurring all costs associated with implementing the programs and related materials.
