## **Bill Analysis**

HB 3171 prohibits any operator of an unmanned aerial vehicle from trespassing onto private property or into airspace within 400 feet of ground level with the intent to subject anyone to eavesdropping or other surveillance, install surveillance devices on personal property without the consent of the owner or lessee, observe or record a person in an area where the person has a reasonable expectation of privacy, or intentionally land a drone on the lands or waters that are the private property of another without the consent of the owner or lessee unless explicitly authorized to do so by law. Violators shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
