**Bill Analysis**

SB 111 adds the crimes of domestic assault and battery that results in great bodily injury to the victim and domestic assault and battery against a pregnant woman with knowledge of pregnancy and as a result, miscarriage or injury to the unborn child to the 85% mandatory minimum sentence crime list. Additionally, the measure removes the option of imprisoning persons convicted of domestic abuse in a county jail for not more than 1 year and requires such persons to be incarcerated under the Department of Corrections.
