Bill Analysis

SB 130 creates the Oklahoma American Heritage Education Act. The measure adds to the list of documents, writings proclamations or records relating to U.S. or Oklahoma history that are permitted to be used in public schools and allows the display of any or all such materials in public schools. The measure also requires each public-school library or equivalent facility to ensure access to certain historical documents, such as the U.S. Constitution, the national anthem and the Declaration of Independence. It allows students to include references to such documents in homework, artwork and written and oral assignments free from discrimination based on religious content and prohibits penalizing or rewarding students based on religious content of their work.
