**Bill Analysis**

SB 1607 prohibits any elected official from using or allowing to be used his or her name, image, likeness, or voice in a public service announcement or in an advertisement or other promotional message created or purchased using public funds 3 months prior to the election in which his or her name is on the ballot. The measure exempts such announcements or advertisements during a declared state disaster or emergency.
