## **Bill Analysis**

SB 706 authorizes any personal delivery device to operate on any sidewalk, crosswalk, road or street of any county or municipality, notwithstanding any other law. The measure requires each device to have a unique identifying device number providing contact information to the owner. The measure prohibits any device from interfering with traffic and obstructing rights of way. Such devices must also travel under 10 miles per hour, be equipped with a controlled stop system, be equipped with lights on the front and back, and obey all relevant traffic laws. Such devices are prohibited from transporting hazardous material. Owners are required to maintain certain insurance requirements on such devices. The measure also preempts any municipal ordinance or law that would otherwise govern the manufacture and contents of personal delivery devices.
