**Bill Analysis**

SB 736 provides for health districts to also be comprised of multiple county health departments operating under agreement to share resources. The measure also provides for the county board of commissioner to be able to contract with a neighboring board of health or board of county commissioners of any county to provide the county any or all public health services. Counties may combine county millage and designate 1 county as the operational hub.
