Bill Analysis

The FS for SB 772 requires persons control wildlife nuisances on a landowner or lessee's land to have received written permission from the owner or lessee. The FS also increases the minimum fine levied on persons convicted of hunting or harassing wildlife without a valid permit or permission from \$250.00 to \$500.00 for the first offense and from \$500.00 to \$5,000.00 for second and subsequent offenses. District attorneys are authorized by the FS to request the revocation of such person's hunting and fishing privileges for a period not to exceed 10 years and not less than 6 months. Residents may pay a \$200.00 reinstatement fee after the period and nonresidents may pay a \$500.00 reinstatement fee after the period. Additionally, the FS authorizes landowners or their designees to control feral and coyote nuisances without limitation by statewide season regulations or bag limits.
