**Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 804 prohibits any person from physically occupying campsites marked as “Reserved” by Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department staff or by the park reservation system. The measure additionally prohibits any person from entering an area of the state park that is identified as an area requiring payment of an entry fee without having first paid the entry fee or being a valid park entry passholder for the date of entry. Violators shall be subject to an administrative fee of \$50.00 for the first offense, \$100.00 for the second offense, and \$250.00 for third and subsequent offenses. Monies from the fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund.
