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**Bill Analysis**

SB 822 expands the category of new motor vehicle dealer to include any person or firm that leases or sells new motor vehicles and used motor vehicles. The measure also prohibits any entity affiliated by any ownership or control of a factory from receiving a license as a motor vehicle dealer. Additionally, the measure creates a new license for new motor vehicle dealers. Such dealers may apply to the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission for permission to ship cars from out-of-state to customers. The Commission may also revoke the license of any factory that used or proposed to use an unreasonable, arbitrary or unfair sales or other standard to measure a dealer's performance under any factory program, failed or refused to sell motor vehicles to its same line-make dealers at the same price, or failed to reimburse a dealer in full for the actual cost of providing a loaner vehicle to any customer. Factories that fail to compensate their dealers for repair work, part replacement, reconditioning, or recall notices shall also be subject to license suspension or removal. The measure establishes a \$300.00 initial fee and \$100.00 annual fee for motor vehicle direct shippers.

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
