16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2021, Section 82.1, is			
18	amended to read as follows:			
19	Section 82.1 A. The designation and dates of holidays in			
20	Oklahoma shall be as follows: Each Saturday, Sunday, New Year's Day			
21	on the 1st day of January, Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday on the			
22	third Monday in January, Presidents' Day on the third Monday in			
23	February, Memorial Day on the last Monday in May, Independence Day			
24	on the 4th day of July, Labor Day on the first Monday in September,			

1 Veterans' Day on the 11th day of November, Thanksgiving Day on the fourth Thursday in November, the day after Thanksgiving Day, 2 Christmas on the 25th day of December, the day before or after 3 4 Christmas if Christmas is not on a Saturday or Sunday, the Thursday 5 and Friday before Christmas if Christmas is on a Saturday, the Monday and Tuesday after Christmas, if Christmas is on a Sunday; and 6 7 if any of such holidays other than Christmas fall on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday in that year and if any of such 8 9 holidays other than Christmas fall on Sunday, the succeeding Monday 10 shall be a holiday in that year.

11 The Governor shall issue an Executive Order each year Β. 12 specifying the dates on which the holidays other than Saturdays and Sundays designated in subsection A of this section occur. 13 If the 14 President of the United States declares any day other than those 15 listed in subsection A of this section as a national holiday, the 16 Governor may issue an Executive Order declaring such day a state 17 holiday.

18 C. Any act authorized, required, or permitted to be performed 19 on a holiday as designated in subsection A of this section may be 20 performed on the next succeeding business day, and no liability or 21 loss of rights of any kind shall result from such delay.

D. State employees, except for temporary and other limited term employees, shall be entitled to a day off work without loss of pay on those holidays specified in an Executive Order issued by the

1 Governor pursuant to subsection B of this section. Those state 2 employees, except for temporary and other limited term employees, who are required to work on a holiday specified in subsection B of 3 this section shall be entitled to a day off work, without loss of 4 5 pay, on an alternative date or payment in lieu thereof at the 6 discretion of the appointing authority and in accordance with rules 7 of the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. E. For the purposes of this section, "holiday" means that 8 9 agencies whose mission does not require them to be open for business 10 every day of the year shall be closed for official business. 11 F. In addition to the holidays specified in subsection A of 12 this section, state employees, except for temporary and other 13 limited term employees, shall be entitled to one personal holiday 14 each year which may be used on Good Friday, Juneteenth, Statehood 15 Day, Indigenous Peoples Day, Columbus Day, or the birthday of the 16 employee. If any of such holidays fall on Saturday, the preceding 17 Friday shall be a holiday in that year, and if any of such holidays 18 fall on Sunday, the succeeding Monday shall be a holiday in that 19 year. 20 SECTION 2.
