Fiscal Analysis

HB 1134 creates a misdemeanor for assault and battery upon a municipal or county code official. A second or subsequent offense is classified as a felony. HB 1134 may increase the prison population in the state, which could also result in higher incarceration costs for the Department of Corrections. Whether these costs increase to an extent that require additional appropriations will depend on the number of arrests and convictions for the offense.
