**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1674 creates a misdemeanor for unlawfully obstructing traffic while participating in a riot. It adds criminal and civil liability protections for motor vehicle operators who unintentionally cause injury or death to an individual participating in a riot under certain circumstances. It also provides that organizations found to be involved with individuals participating in riots or unlawful assemblies shall be punished by a fine that is ten times the amount of the fine authorized by the appropriate provision of the bill. The fiscal impact of this bill is contingent upon the number of convictions for the offenses listed in the bill.
