## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2179 engrossed version of HB 2179 changes the flat annual license fee of \$2,500 for medical marijuana commercial growers to a graduated fee structure based on the square foot of the canopy of plants, and on the type of grow facility: indoor, greenhouse or light deprivation, and outdoor. It also provides definitions and replaces references to the Department of Health with the OK Medical Marijuana Authority. OMMA reports that this will certainly increase licensing fee revenue, but they currently have no way of knowing how much revenue will be generated as they do not have data regarding current sizes of grows.
