Fiscal Analysis

SB 669 increases the maximum term of imprisonment for assaulting a current or former intimate partner or family/household member and for knowingly assaulting a pregnant woman. It also increases both the minimum and maximum term of imprisonment for committing domestic abuse in the presence of a child. The fiscal impact of this bill is contingent on the number of people convicted of the crimes outlined in the bill and the length of the imposed sentence. The average daily cost per inmate for maximum, medium, and minimum security is \$108.17, \$61.71, and \$57.39 respectively.
