Fiscal Analysis

SB 865 expands the scope and definition of human trafficking. The fiscal impact of this bill is contingent on the number of people convicted of the offenses outlined in the bill and the length of the imposed sentence. The average daily cost per inmate for maximum, medium, and minimum security is \$108.17, \$61.71, and \$57.39 respectively.
