**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB2899 states that applications for Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver Services for the Community Waiver, In-Home Supports Waiver for Adults, and In-Home Supports Waiver for Children operated by the Department of Human Services cannot be made until the applicant has been an Oklahoma resident for 5 years prior to the application date. The Department of Human Services shall promulgate rules necessary for implementation and administration.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2899 would limit the new applicants from Department of Human Services' Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver Services for Community, In-Home Supports Waiver for Adults, and In-Home Supports Waiver for Children. The measure puts in place a 5-year waiting period for new residents. Such limitation is likely to limit cost growth for the listed programs.
