**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 3258 modifies the elements of the crime of sodomy by providing that the crime of forcible sodomy occurs when committed against a student at a secondary school who is concurrently enrolled at an institution of higher education by an employee of the institution. The measure provides a definition of "employee of an institution of higher education". The measure also modifies the crimes of rape, rape by instrumentation, and lewd molestation by including where the victim is a student at a secondary school but is concurrently enrolled at an institution of higher education and engages in sexual intercourse with a person who is three or more years of age older than the concurrently enrolled student and is an employee of the institution of higher education.
