**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3811 in its current form provides exemption to certain Secretary of State registration fees under certain conditions. The Secretary of State is a non-appropriated state agency, provisions of this measure have no direct impact on state revenues available for appropriation during the FY-23 Fiscal Year. Any lost registration fee revenue is currently expected to be absorbed within the Secretary of State's existing budgetary resources.
