Research Analysis

The floor substitute to HB 4327 prohibits a legislator or statewide official from knowingly conveying false or misleading information through direct or indirect communications. FA1 provides the requirements for civil action against a person. The measure also specifies damages in a prevailing lawsuit.

The floor substitute provides defenses to state claims and specifies instances that are not considered a defense to an action. Lastly, the measure creates new definitions.
