16	A. There is hereby created the Office of Trauma-Informed Care.
17	B. The Office shall have the following duties and
18	responsibilities:
19	1. Identify an existing entity with a broad, statewide presence
20	to be the Advisory Board for the Office;
21	2. Promote, organize, and/or conduct professional training
22	opportunities relating to trauma-informed care across the public and
23	private sectors;
24	3. Align trauma-training pathways and/or certification options;

- 4. Assist with making trauma-informed care resources easily accessible by phone, social media, and websites for individuals seeking such services;
- 5. Increase coordination between trauma-informed services in prevention, secondary prevention, and treatment across the lifespan with a special emphasis on maternal health and early childhood from zero (0) to five (5) years of age;
- 6. Create and sustain a plan directing offices and other units of government to collaborate, prioritize options for, and implement a coordinated approach to prevent trauma, especially Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs);
- 7. Identify and implement the appropriate interventions and supports for children, youth, and their families;
- 8. Create an advisory group of individuals with lived experiences that would be related to or considered trauma to inform the leadership of the Office; and
- 9. Carry out such other matters related to trauma-informed care
 18 as the Office deems relevant.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
