- 1. At any time from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset to one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise, also referred to in this chapter title as nighttime; and
- 2. At any other time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand (1,000) feet or less; and
- 3. At all times during conditions of rain. If the vehicle's windshield wipers are on during conditions of rain, the vehicle's headlamps shall be on.
- C. All lamps required by this chapter title shall display a steady light except as otherwise prescribed by this chapter title. Any required individual lamp may be combined or incorporated with any other required individual lamp if the combined or incorporated lamps meet all of the individual lighting requirements of this chapter title for each individual lamp contained therein.
- D. No lamp, other than a headlamp, displayed on any vehicle shall project a glaring light; provided, every headlamp shall comply with Section $\frac{12-222}{12-203.2}$ of this title.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
