7	An Act relating to state government; directing the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.2 of Title 74, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES)
17	shall contract for the study, analysis, and planning on the
18	feasibility of consolidating all computer systems for state, county,
19	and municipal law enforcement agencies in Oklahoma. The study shall
20	examine the cost to develop an information technology system that
21	will ensure seamless communication and data collection among the law
22	enforcement agencies and shall also:
23	1. Identify and assess the requirements for developing a
24	comprehensive law enforcement information technology system by

creating a multilayer framework that shall allow for the sharing of law enforcement information;

- 2. Identify and determine the critical interfaces that have not yet been captured in existing law enforcement information technology systems;
- 3. Identify and review current information technology capabilities of state, county, and local law enforcement entities throughout the state including records management systems and computer-aided dispatch systems; and
- 4. Identify and review the feasibility of consolidating data collection and accessibility into fewer systems.
- B. OMES shall be exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act for the purpose of soliciting, negotiating, and effectuating such a contract or contracts.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
