6 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
9 to refer to the people for their approval or  
10 rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of  
11 the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 13 to  
12 Article XXIII; creating the Oklahoma Certificate of  
13 Merit Act; providing ballot title; and directing  
14 filing.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
16 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
19 the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of  
20 Oklahoma by adding a new Section 13 to Article XXIII thereof, to  
21 read as follows:

22 Section 13. This act shall be known and may be cited as the  
23 "Oklahoma Certificate of Merit Act".

24 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure adds a new section to the Oklahoma Constitution.

It creates the Oklahoma Certificate of Merit Act.
