7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to schools; directing an
9 administrator of a school district or technology
10 center school district to be dismissed or not
11 reemployed for violating certain law subject to
12 certain due process procedures; prohibiting
13 administrator subject to certain provisions from
14 serving in certain position for certain period of
15 time; providing for codification; providing an
16 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.190.1 of Title 70, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Upon the effective date of this act, if a school district or
22 technology center school district administrator has knowingly
23 violated any state law relevant to public education or within Title
24 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the administrator shall not be
qualified to serve in the position. The administrator shall be

1 dismissed or not reemployed, subject to the provisions of the
2 Teacher Due Process Act of 1990. The administrator shall be
3 prohibited from serving in any role, paid or unpaid, for public
4 schools in this state for a period of five (5) years.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
