To qualify as a Purple Star School, a school district site 9 or charter school site shall: 10 Designate a school employee as a military liaison whose 1. 11 duties include: 12 identifying military-connected students enrolled at а. 13 the school who are designated with a military student 14 identifier as provided for in Section 3-168 of Title 15 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, 16 b. serving as the point of contact between the school and 17 military-connected students and their families, 18 determining appropriate school services available to с. 19 military-connected students, and 20 d. assisting in coordinating school programs relevant to 21 military-connected students; 22 2.
