L2	WHEREAS, Janet Jo Jefferis McMeans Tompkins was born in 1922
L3	during the days of prohibition, jazz, and flappers; and
L 4	WHEREAS, after the United States entered World War II, Janet Jo
L5	saw her three male cousins serving in the war and thought she could
16	do it too; and
L7	WHEREAS, she enlisted in the Naval Reserves on Oct. 23, 1943.
L8	She was accepted in the Women's Reserve, U.S. Naval Reserve,
L 9	Apprentice Seamen, Class V-9, received her orders and reported to
20	her commanding officer on Dec. 9, 1943; and
21	WHEREAS, at 21 years of age, Janet Jo took her oath of
22	enlistment. Seaman Jefferis learned the basics about airplanes and
23	boats, studied Morse Code and flag signaling; and

1 WHEREAS, on April 4, 1944, Janet Jo was assigned for duty to the 2 Communications Intelligence Subdivision in the Washington D.C. 3 Office of Naval Communications. She worked in a top-secret office, 4 and Janet Jo lived by the code of "loose lips sink ships"; and 5 WHEREAS, Janet Jo was promoted to Lieutenant on July 1, 1945, 6 and was awarded the Navy Unit Commendation in 1946. 7 commendations at the end of the war included World War II Victory 8 Ribbon, American Theatre Ribbon, Navy Unit Commendation, and 9 American Campaign Medal; and 10 WHEREAS, on June 5, 1946, Janet Jo was given her honorable 11 discharge and her notice of separation from the U.S. Naval Service, 12 but remained a member of the Naval Reserves until March 21, 1951. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION 14 OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 15 CONCURRING THEREIN: 16 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature is excited to celebrate Lt. 17 Janet Jo Jefferis McMeans Tompkins' 100th birthday in July. 18 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature applauds her service to our 19 nation during World War II and recognizes her as an Oklahoma and a 20 national treasure. 21 22 3/29/2022 11:44:58 AM 58-2-3756 KΑ 23 24
