8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code  
9 Commission; prohibiting any provision from being  
10 enacted to prohibit or limit use of refrigerant  
11 designated as federally acceptable; requiring  
12 installation of certain equipment to maintain certain  
13 standards and conditions; providing for codification;  
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.30 of Title 59, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 No provision of a building code, any other law, regulation, or  
20 other requirement in Oklahoma may prohibit or otherwise limit the  
21 use of a refrigerant designated as acceptable for use pursuant to  
22 and in accordance with 42 U.S.C., Section 7671K; provided, any  
23 equipment containing such refrigerant is listed and installed in  
24 accordance with safety standards and use conditions imposed pursuant  
to such designation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
