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11 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement
13 Revolving Fund; making an appropriations to the fund;
14 specifying amounts and source; stating purposes;
15 providing for noncodification; providing an effective
16 date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement
21 Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 30.6 of Title 74 of the
22 Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
23 the Opioid Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury,

1 the sum of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) to be budgeted
2 and expended in accordance with law.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement
6 Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 30.6 of Title 74 of the
7 Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
8 the Opioid Lawsuit Settlement Fund (Fund 383) of the State Treasury,
9 the sum of Five Million Seven Hundred Ninety Thousand Six Hundred
10 Fifty-one Dollars (\$5,790,651.00) to be distributed to non-
11 litigating subdivisions.

12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

13 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
