14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

17	A. Any person who, without justifiable or excusable cause,								
18	commits any assault, battery, or assault and battery upon the person

20	performance of his or her duties shall, upon conviction, be guilty								
21	of a misdemeanor punishable by a term of imprisonment in the county								
22	jail for a period not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not

- B. Any person who, without justifiable or excusable cause, commits any aggravated battery or aggravated assault and battery upon the person of a county employee while such county employee is in the performance of his or her duties shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a term of imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a period not exceeding two (2) years, or by a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
 - C. For purposes of this section:
- 1. "Aggravated assault and battery" shall have the same meaning as such term is defined by Section 646 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 2. "Assault" shall have the same meaning as such term is defined in Section 641 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 3. "Battery" shall have the same meaning as such term is defined by Section 642 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
- 4. "County employee" means an employee of the county, any duly appointed person employed by a county, or employees of a firm contracting with a county.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
