All monies accruing to the credit of the Oklahoma School Safety
Training Program Revolving Fund are hereby appropriated and may be
budgeted and expended by the State Department of Education for the
purposes of:

10 Implementation of a crisis management solution. This consists 11 of a hard-wired notification system for identifying the location of a threat notifying staff, law enforcement, and first responders. 12 13 The notification system shall also notify staff via text, email, and 14 voice alert. The system must also address the time gap issue from 15 the beginning of a violent event until law enforcement support can 16 arrive and end the threat. The crisis management solution shall 17 provide training and implementation of a variety of secured response 18 options, including threshold protection, escape and evade options, 19 and trauma first aid items.

Expenditures from the Oklahoma School Safety Training Program Revolving Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
