11	An Act relating to security of public buildings; directing certain entities to contract with the
12	Department of Public Safety for certain services; amending 73 O.S. 2021, Section 173, which relates to
13	the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority; updating statutory language; removing certain references;
14	providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1096 of Title 64, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	The Commissioners of the Land Office and the Office of
22	Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) shall contract with the
23	Department of Public Safety for security and law enforcement
24	services in all facilities under the jurisdiction of the

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Commissioners of the Land Office, OMES, or the Department within the
 State Capitol Park in Oklahoma City and the Executive Center at 201
 West 5th Street and appurtenances thereto in Tulsa.

4 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2021, Section 173, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 Section 173. A. The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority may 7 contract with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to 8 maintain grounds and for housekeeping, maintenance and repair of 9 properties under the jurisdiction of the Authority.

B. The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority and the Office of
Management and Enterprise Services shall contract with the
Department of Public Safety for security and law enforcement
services in all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Authority
or Department within <u>"State Capitol Park"</u> the State Capitol Park in
Oklahoma City and the J. Howard Edmondson Office Building, Robert S.
Kerr Office Building and appurtenances thereto in Tulsa.

C. The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority shall provide
office and operations space for Office of Management and Enterprise
Services' Services functions.

20 D. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall 21 establish accounts for the Office of Management and Enterprise 22 Services, by building or other improvement, as the Director of the 23 Office of Management and Enterprise Services considers necessary to 24 properly account and identify receipts and expenditures related to

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1	construction, repair, maintenance, insurance and other operating
2	expenses of buildings and improvements owned, used or occupied by or
3	on behalf of the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority, where the
4	services are carried out by contract with the Authority.
5	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
6	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
