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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.20D of Title 74, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Any full-time employee of this state who has been employed
19	for at least two years prior to the request shall be granted a paid
20	leave of absence, for twelve (12) weeks for the birth or adoption of
21	the employee's child.
22	B. An employee who is granted a leave of absence pursuant to
23	the provisions of this section shall receive their annual salary
24	without interruption during the leave of absence. For purposes of

1	determining seniority, pay or pay advancement, and performance
2	awards, and for the receipt of any benefit that may be affected by a
3	leave of absence, the service of the employee shall be considered
4	uninterrupted by the leave of absence.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
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
