8	An Act relating to state parks; amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2212, which relates to powers, rights,
9	and privileges of Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission; providing for legislative approval for
10	certain property decision; updating statutory language; and providing an effective date.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2212, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 2212. <u>A.</u> The <u>Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation</u>
17	Commission shall have the authority to exercise the following
18	powers, rights and privileges related to state parks:
19	1. Have the exclusive possession and control of, and to operate
20	and maintain for the benefit of the people of the State of Oklahoma
21	this state, all state parks and all lands and other properties now
22	or hereafter owned or leased by the state or Commission for park or
23	recreational purposes;

Acquire Except as provided in subsection B of this section, acquire by purchase, exchange, lease, gift, condemnation, or in any 2 other manner and to maintain, use and operate any and all property, 3 real, personal or mixed, necessary or convenient to the exercise of 4 5 the powers, rights, privileges and functions conferred upon it by the Oklahoma Tourism, Parks and Recreation Enhancement Act. Title 6 to all such property shall be vested in the State of Oklahoma this 7 state, although such property is sometimes herein referred to as 8 9 property "of the Commission". The power of condemnation herein 10 granted shall be exercised in the manner provided by the general laws of the state for the condemnation of property by the state; 11 12 3. Subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Tourism, Parks and Recreation Enhancement Act, from time to time lease, without 13 restriction as to term, any property which the Commission shall 14 determine to be necessary or convenient to more fully carry into 15 effect the duties and powers of said the Commission; and 16 4. Acquire, conserve, protect, construct, extend, reduce, 17 improve, maintain and operate any and all facilities of all kinds 18 which in the judgment of the Commission will provide recreational or 19 other facilities for the benefit of the public, or which are 20

21 necessary or convenient to the exercise of the powers of the 22 Commission.

elects not to renew a lease for real property upon which a state
